Exodus 26:30-36

31 "And you shall make a veil of blue and purple and scarlet yarns and fine twined linen. It shall be made with cherubim skillfully worked into it.

32 And you shall hang it on four pillars of acacia overlaid with gold, with hooks of gold, on four bases of silver.

33 And you shall hang the veil from the clasps, and bring the ark of the testimony in there within the veil. And the veil shall separate for you the Holy Place from the Most Holy.

34 You shall put the mercy seat on the ark of the testimony in the Most Holy Place.

35 And you shall set the table outside the veil, and the lampstand on the south side of the tabernacle opposite the table, and you shall put the table on the north side.

36 "You shall make a screen for the entrance of the tent, of blue and purple and scarlet yarns and fine twined linen, embroidered with needlework.

You Win Either Way

"For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain...I am torn between the two: I desire to depart and be with Christ, which is better by far; but it is more necessary for you that I remain in the body" (Phil. 1:21,23-24 NIV).

People do all they can to put off death. Because they do not believe in a hereafter, they do not see death as gain. But Paul says to die is "**gain**" and that to depart is "**far better**." Why? How so? Read the "no mores" of Revelation 21:1-4 and 22:3 and you will understand. Right now we are "in Christ" but some day we will be "with Christ."

But either way, we win. If we are living for Christ now we can be assured that some day we will live with Christ forever. "**To live is Christ.**" What does Paul mean? Let him explain this mystery. "**I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me**" (Gal. 2:20 NKJV). Your "life force" is Jesus Christ Himself who lives in you. The life you now live is by your firm faith and total trust in Him.
