Acts 26:24-30

24 While *Paul* was saying this in his defense, Festus *said in a loud voice, "Paul, you are out of your mind! *Your* great learning is driving you mad." **25** But Paul said, "I am not out of my mind, most excellent Festus, but I utter words of sober truth. **26** For the king knows about these matters, and I speak to him also with confidence, since I am persuaded that none of these things escape his notice; for this has not been done in a corner. **27** King Agrippa, do you believe the Prophets?
