Mark 8:5-13

5 And He was asking them, "How many loaves do you have?" And they said, "Seven." **6** And He directed the people to sit down on the ground; and taking the seven loaves, He gave thanks and broke them, and started giving them to His disciples to serve to them, and they served them to the people. **7** They also had a few small fish; and after He had blessed them, He ordered these to be served as well. **8** And they ate and were satisfied; and they picked up seven large baskets full of what was left over of the broken pieces. **9** About four thousand were *there*; and He sent them away. **10** And immediately He entered the boat with His disciples and came to the district of Dalmanutha. **11** The Pharisees came out and began to argue with Him, seeking from Him a sign from heaven, to test Him. **12** Sighing deeply in His spirit, He *said, "Why does this generation seek for a sign?
